CONTEST RULES

1. Club dues are \$5.00 and pen rental is \$.50 per cage. Dues and pen rental are to be paid at fair check-in.
2. All roasters, broilers, turkeys and waterfowl to be exhibited must be purchased from the club on a designated date, and same birds exhibited.
3. All birds except roasters and broilers are to be in your possession as of April 1 of current year.
4. Members must register birds at the June meeting in order to exhibit birds. There will be no changes in birds registered after the July meeting unless to delete from exhibition.
5. Record books will need to be completed and turned in at the June meeting. Journals will be completed and turned in at fair check-in.
6. All birds to be exhibited must meet State Health Requirements. Any birds showing signs of illness/disease or parasites will be sent home.
7. Poultry coops, feeding cups, feed and watering system will be furnished.
8. Only one entry (single, pairs, etc.) per class.
9. Classes identified starting with a letter (A 100, etc.) are local classes only and are not eligible for state fair.
10. Exhibitors must be present for judging and auction of their birds in proper dress (blue jeans and poultry tee shirt).
11. The 4-H'er will be responsible for getting bird to show table. If necessary to have help, make prior arrangement with another 4-H'er. If birds are not on show table after two calls, they will be scratched from exhibition.
12. All birds to be auctioned must be of commercial weight. Approximate weights are: Roasters: 5.5 – 10 lbs.; Broilers: 3.5 – 5.5 lbs.; Hen Turkeys: 12 lbs.; Tom Turkeys: 18 lbs.; Young Ducks: 5-6 lbs.; & Goose: 12-14 lbs.
13. Each exhibitor may auction two meat classes. These classes will be reported to the leader by no later than noon the Monday before the auction.
14. 5% of the selling price will be donated back to the Poultry Club for club expenses.
15. Birds will be removed from the Poultry Barn by 7:00 p.m. on Fri., July 30 to clean the barn. The leadership and the club will not be responsible for those left after check-out time.
16. Exhibitors should not take birds back to their home flocks unless the birds are isolated for two weeks.
17. The Poultry Club leaders and advisory board will rule on any special situations arising, and this decision will be final.

4-H COMMERCIAL CHICKEN CLASSES

1. Each section number signifies a separate class of birds.
2. Judging: Special attention will be given to growth, development, and production qualities.

DESCRIPTION OF CLASSES:

Pullets: two females hatched between January 1 & April 1 of current year and in your possession by April 1 of current year. Hens: two females, in laying condition, hatched before January 1 and in your possession by April 1 of current year.

EGG-TYPE CLASSES:

White shell, white ear lobe
7301 – two pullets
7302 – two hens
Brown shell, red ear lobe
7303 – two pullets
7304 – two hens

MEAT-TYPE CLASSES (Cornish Cross)

7307 – two broilers (same sex) 6-8 weeks of age and not over 5 ½ lbs. on show day.
7308 – one roaster (either sex) 8-12 weeks of age and 5 ½ lbs. on show day.

4-H AND OPEN CLASS CHICKEN BARBECUE RULES

Wednesday, July 28, 2004

4-H: 9:30 a.m.

Open Class: 10:00 a.m.

Pre-register by July 23, 2003.

1. The 4-H Barbecue Project Manual and record will be your reference guide and the record sheet included in the booklet will be turned in at the end of the project.
2. Each participant must be 12 years old or older. You need not be in the 4-H Poultry Club to participate.
3. Each participant must use chicken provided by the 4-H Poultry Club for the contest. Two halves will be provided, and will be weighed prior to and after the barbecuing.
4. Each participant will provide his or her own grill, brickettes, starting fluid, matches, water for containing fire, shovel or trowel or such equipment needed. 4-H participants must use charcoal grills. Open class may use either charcoal or L.P. grills.
5. Each participant must provide their own sauce, apron, dauber, tongs, gloves, foil or other equipment needed. Each participant must also provide a plate and fork for the judge.
6. Each first year participant will use the same recipe for sauce.
 - 2 c. vinegar
 - 1 c. water
 - Salt to taste
 - ½ lb. butterPut in saucepan and boil together for 1 minute.
7. Be ready to start your fire at least 1 hour before barbecuing. All chickens will be placed on the grill at 9:30 a.m. for 4-H'ers and 10:00 a.m. for Open Class. Time will be called at 12 Noon for 4-H, and 1:00 p.m. for Open Class.
8. Each participant will put out their own coals and clean their own cooking area.
